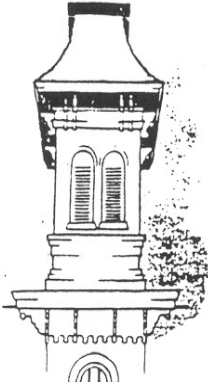

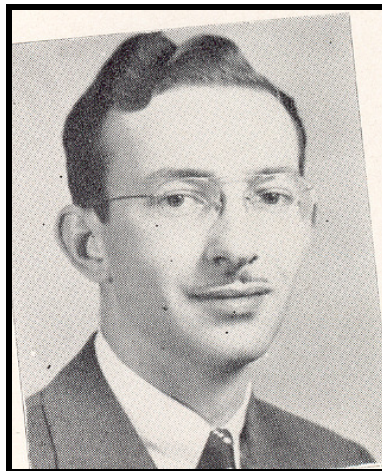
Highlighting Friday evening's event is the fiftieth anniversary of the class of 1956. All who attended Milton College during the 1950's are encouraged to come. Renewing old friendships and acquaintances has always made this a popular event.

One of the big events for Saturday is a presentation by former Professor Herbert MacDonell. Herb taught chemistry at Milton from 1951-1954 and went on to become an expert on human bloodstain evidence in the world of forensics. He has conducted over 100 seminars and workshops on human blood evidence in several countries and has been an expert witness in numerous civil and criminal cases, including the O.J. Simpson, Robert Kennedy, Martin Luther King, Jr., and Black Panther cases. His presentation on Saturday is free, open to the public, and will be held in the Chapel at Main Hall.

Herb's distinguished career will be honored at the Saturday evening dinner to be held at The Gathering Place in Milton. According to those who have kept in touch with him, his remarks will again "prove to be of great interest". The dinner itself will be a catered event by Best Events of Janesville and will round out a pleasant evening with friends.

Be sure and visit the exhibits at Main Hall during the open house hours. The re-organized archives will take you down memory lane with photos and other information of Milton College history.
